RESOLUTION NO. 2010- ²⁹

Re: Special Election for Formation of Mosquito Control District #3 Idlewild

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners received a petition to form the Idlewild Mosquito Control District in accordance with Chapter 17.28 of the Revised Code of Washington; and

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2009, the Chelan County Auditor duly certified said petition indicating sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 17.28 RCW, a public hearing was conducted on February 16, 2010 to consider said petition; and

WHEREAS, at said public hearing the Board of County Commissioners considered the testimony offered by the public regarding the establishment of said district and the proposed boundary lines therefore; and

WHEREAS, at said public hearing the testimony offered generally consisted of favorable comments for formation and that with integrated pest control the environment would be protected; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners considered whether the public necessity or welfare of the proposed territory and of its inhabitants required the formation of the district and considered whether the petition complied with the provisions of Chapter 17.28 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners further considered the finalization of the boundaries of said proposed district,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Chelan County Commissioners finds that the official title of the proposed district shall be the "Mosquito Control District #3 Idlewild" and that the following legal description shall establish the definite and final boundary lines of the proposed Idlewild Mosquito Control District:

The boundaries of the area proposed to be organized as a mosquito control district is legally described as: Government Lot 2 of Section 22, T.27N., R.17 E.W.M., Platted as Idlewild Summer Homes

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners finds that the public necessity or welfare of the proposed territory and of its inhabitants requires the formation of said district, and also finds that the petition sufficiently complies with the provisions of Chapter 17.28 RCW; and

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that a special election shall be conducted by the Chelan County Auditor within the boundaries of the proposed district on Tuesday, April 27, 2010, by mail-in ballots shall be mailed by the Auditor's office to the registered voters within the proposed boundaries twenty (20) days prior to the election; ballots must be returned to the Auditor's office postmarked no later than April 27, 2010 the Auditor's office Election Department shall serve as the designated polling place where ballots may be left during regular working hours or between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on election day; and

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that this notice of special election shall also be published at least once a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the county; and

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the ballot for said special election shall be in the following form:

"Shall a mosquito control district be established for the area described in Resolution 2010- 29 adopted by the Board of Chelan County Commissioners on March 8, 2010" BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that at the same special election there shall be submitted to the voters residing within the district, for their approval or rejection, a proposition authorizing the mosquito control district, if formed, to levy at the earliest time permitted by law on all taxable property located within the mosquito control district a general tax, for one year, of up to 10¢ per \$1,000.00 of assessed value in excess of any constitutional and statutory limitation for the authorized purposes of a mosquito control district. The proposition shall be expressed on the ballot in substantially the following form: "One year 10¢ per \$1,000.00 of assessed value levy." "Shall the mosquito control district, if formed, levy a general tax of 10¢ per \$1,000.00 of assessed value for one year upon all the taxable property within said district in excess of the constitutional and/or statutory tax limits for authorized purposes of the district?" Yes _____ No ____ The proposition to be effective must be approved by a majority of at least three/fifths (3/5ths) of the persons voting on the proposition to levy such tax in the manner set forth in Article VII, Section 2(a) of the Constitution of this State, as amended by Amendment 59 and as thereafter amended. **DATED** at Wenatchee, Washington this 8th day of March, 2010.
