AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF _____,
WASHINGTON, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 20__

WHEREAS, the City of _____, Washington completed and placed on file with the City Clerk a proposed budget and estimate of the amount of moneys required to meet the public expenses, bond retirement and interest, reserve funds, and expenses of government of the City for the fiscal year ending December 31, 20__; and

WHEREAS, a notice was published that the City Council would meet on December ____, 20__ at ____ p.m., in the council chambers of city hall for the purpose of making and adopting a budget for said fiscal year and giving taxpayers within the limits of the City an opportunity to be heard in a public hearing upon said budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council did hold a public hearing at that time and place and did then consider the matter of the proposed budget for the fiscal year 20__; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget does not exceed the lawful limit of taxation allowed by law to be levied on the property within the City for the purposes set forth in the budget, and the estimated expenditures set forth in the budget being all necessary to carry on the government of the City for the fiscal year 20__ and being sufficient to meet the various needs of the City during that period;

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of _____, do ordain as follows:¹

SECTION 1. The budget for the City of _____, Washington for the year 20__ is hereby adopted at the fund level in its final form and content as set forth in the comprehensive budget document, “(give exact title of your budget document)”, copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

¹ The enactment clause provided is for code cities and cities of the second class. For towns and cities formed under RCW 35.17.030 the enactment clause varies. See the MRSC publication, [Local Ordinance for Washington Cities and Counties](#), page 7 for language requirements.

² Code cities must transmit to the State Auditor's Office and to the Association of Washington Cities (AWC). All other classifications (except for 1st class with populations greater than 300,000) are required to transmit only to AWC. First class cities with populations greater than 300,000 do not have to transmit the budget document.
