**WHEREAS**, the work performed by Associated Underwater Services, Inc. of Kenmore, Washington, under contract for Reservoir #2 – Tank Repair Project, Job #24-002 TO13, has been examined by the City of Benton City (City) Public Works Staff and been found to be in apparent compliance with the applicable project specifications and drawings; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the City Public Works Staff's recommendation that the City formally accept the contractor's work and the project as complete.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENTON CITY, WASHINGTON:**

That the City Council concurs with the City Public Works Staff's recommendation and thereby accepts the work performed by Associated Underwater Services, Inc. of Kenmore, Washington, under contract Reservoir #2- Tank Repair Project, Job #24-002 TO13, as being completed in apparent compliance with the project specifications and drawings.

**Be It Further Resolved**, that the City Clerk is hereby directed to notify the Washington State Department of Revenue of this acceptance.

**Be It Further Resolved**, that the final payment of retainage being withheld, pursuant to RCW 60.28.011, regulations and administrative process, shall be released upon apparent compliance with and satisfaction of applicable project specifications and verification thereof by the City Public Works Director and the City Clerk/Treasurer.

Subject: Benton City 24-002 TO 13 – Reservoir #2- Tank Repair Recommendation of Acceptance

Associated Underwater Services Inc. completed work in apparent compliance with the plans and specifications, as inspected by City Public Works. I recommend the City accept the project by Resolution in the amount of \$82,313.08 less 5% retainage. Substantial completion was on May 16, 2025.

A "Notice of Completion of Public Works" will be filed with the Department of Revenue, the Department of Labor and Industries and the Employment Security Department, to ensure prevailing wages were paid, all taxes were paid and other state fees were paid. Once clearance is granted by each agency, the City can release the retainage amount of \$4,115.65.
