

Yes = 17	Additional Comments
Bremerton	Yes we do
Camas	Yes, Camas uses Chip Seal on arterials and other roadways.
Coupeville	Yes, we do.
Edgewood	Yes, Edgewood has an annual chip seal program that we coordinate with Pierce County Public Works.
Ellensburg	Yes, the City of Ellensburg uses chip seals on our arterials, but only use asphalt overlays in certain sections of town.
Gig Harbor	Yes, Gig Harbor uses "chip seals" as a surface treatment on arterials in limited circumstances. That said, Gig Harbor primarily uses "chip seals" on local roadways.
Lakewood	The City of Lakewood uses chip seal annually through contract.
Longview	Yes we use chipseal surface treatment on any asphalt surface. We primarily use oil CRS2P and 3/8-4 rock.
Newport	I checked with our Public Works Director and he said that at the City of Newport uses chip seal on arterials and occasionally on non-arterials as well.
Port Townsend	Subject to Port Townsend passing a Transportation Benefit District tax, the City will plan on using chip seals for arterials. It has been about 20 years since chip seals were used on arterials... so this will be reinstating a previous practice. I'd be curious to hear the results of your question.
Puyallup	Puyallup has one arterial in this years Chip Seal/Fog Seal program. E Pioneer from 16 th St SE to Shaw Rd will be resurfaced this month with a 3/8ths chip rock and completed with a fog seal. Please let us know if you have any additional questions.
Shoreline	The City of Shoreline has used chip seal on arterials, but this is not the norm. Chip seal is more typically used on local streets. We are looking at our chip seal program and would appreciate seeing the results of your "survey".
Spokane	The City of Spokane does use Chip Seal as a surface treatment on arterial streets.
Sprague	Yes, if the funding calls for it, we do. Sprague Public Works personally doesn't we contract with Lincoln County Public Works to do our roads.
Tacoma	Yes. We most definitely chip seal arterial streets.
Wenatchee	The City of Wenatchee uses chip seal as a surface treatment for arterials and other classifications of streets
White Salmon	We do currently have a chip seal project going on now, but most of the streets in White Salmon that could be chip sealed have already been chip sealed so it is a process that we are looking to move away from.

No = 20	Additional Comments
Anacortes	The City of Anacortes uses chip seal surface treatment but we have not yet used it on arterial roadways. To date we have used an interlocal with Skagit County to perform this work but this year we contacted out a portion of our chip seal.
Auburn	We have used chip seal on some minor arterials and collectors in the past but we have not used it on a major arterial roadways recently.
Chelan	Historically the City of Chelan has utilized chip seal as a surface treatment but has not for over a decade. We are currently looking at reintroducing it as a treatment for select areas as it is a very cost effective solution for pavement preservation.
East Wenatchee	East Wenatchee only uses it on local access and low volume collectors. I would be interested to see what feedback other agencies have when it's used on higher volume roads.
Everett	Everett does not. Mukilteo used to and may still. Snohomish County is very proficient with their chip seal program.
Federal Way	Federal Way does not use chip seal.
Ferndale	City of Ferndale does not currently utilize chip seal.
Friday Harbor	The Town of Friday Harbor uses Chipseal as maintenance lifts with our County through an interlocal on limited roads on the travel lane only.
Kirkland	The City of Kirkland does not use chip seal on any of our roads. I believe the last time chip seal was used within The City of Kirkland was in the early 2000's. If you need to know the specifics just let me know.
Lake Forest Park	We used to use chip seal several years ago, but the response from our community was a resounding "No". Chip seal may work in rural areas, but in an urban environment, it's problematic at best. I've worked in 3 other cities with populations of 30k, 300k, and 900k, and none will use chip seal.
Langley	We have not used Chip Seal in the City of Langley.
Monroe	The City of Monroe has used the chip seal preservation treatment in the past. The City has selected to no longer use this treatment. This change was due to generally unsupportive feedback from residents and businesses about the chip seal process and the final product.
Normandy Park	We have used chip seal in the past but have since moved to asphalt overlays as the preferred method.
Port Orchard	We have not used this method yet. We plan on implementing it in the next couple of years where it may be beneficial. Local access roads, collectors, etc.

Raymond	The City of Raymond has used chip seal once in the past 20-years. So that probably equates to a NO we don't use chip seal...
SeaTac	SeaTac does not
Sequim	Nope!!!
Tukwila	we don't use chip seal in our City.
Winthrop	Lisa, we really don't have arterials. We use chip seal on all streets in town except State Route 20.
Yakima	We here at the City of Yakima utilize chip seal to extend the life of our roadways. We stay away from main arterials and focus on collector and residential streets. Our goal is to chip seal approximately 20 miles per year.
