

RESOLUTION NO. 1214 (2008)

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOTHELL,
APPROVING A REGIONAL WATER CONSERVATION GOAL**

WHEREAS, the City of Bothell operates a Water Utility which provides potable water and fire protection to Bothell citizens within the utility's service area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bothell desires to establish a water conservation goal, to comply with the requirements of the Municipal Water Supply Efficiency Requirements Act of 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bothell belongs to the Saving Water Partnership, a consortium of 18 water utilities that together are implementing conservation programs to meet the regional conservation goal.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Bothell as follows:

Section 1. The City of Bothell hereby adopts the six-year regional water conservation goal of reducing per capita average consumption by 1% per year.

Section 2. The City Clerk is authorized to make necessary corrections to this resolution including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, resolution numbering, section/subsection numbers and any references thereto.
