

**ORDINANCE NO. 2871**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ISSAQUAH, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF A KING COUNTY METRO VAN FOR THE ISSAQUAH SENIOR CENTER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, King County has a program which allows for the donation of King County metro vans to eligible non-profit agencies and local governments to meet the mobility needs of senior citizens, people with disabilities, young people, and low-income people; and

WHEREAS, the Issaquah Senior Center has been chosen as a recipient of a 2011 Dodge Caravan through this program; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 35.21.100 and the City's Financial Policies, the City is allowed, by ordinance, to accept monetary and property donations; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISSAQUAH, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Donation Accepted. The City of Issaquah hereby accepts the donation of the 2011 Dodge Caravan through King County's Metro Transit Department van donation program for use at the Issaquah Senior City and agrees to abide by the donation terms established by King County Code 4.56.100(E).

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.
