WHEREAS: President Joe Biden signed a bill making June 19 – Juneteenth a federal holiday and;


WHEREAS: the State of Washington effective July 25, 2021, passed House Bill 1016 making June 19 – Juneteenth a legal holiday and;

WHEREAS: under limited circumstances, no court is open or judicial business transacted on a legal holiday, RCW 2.28.100, and:

WHEREAS: the Courthouse, Public Works, and Sheriff's collective bargaining agreements are in effect until the end of 2022, and the Jail Guild until 2023. The Board will grant authorization for the calendar year 2022.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners Asotin County, Washington does hereby authorize Juneteenth (Monday, June 20, 2022) as a recognized holiday for calendar year 2022.


