RESOLUTION NO. 23-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, WASHINGTON, INITIATING A STREET VACATION AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING DATE TO CONSIDER THE VACATION OF JEFFERSON AVENUE BETWEEN SR 410 AND SOUTH RIVER AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Buckley City Council believes it may be in the public interest to vacate Jefferson Street located between SR 410 and South River Avenue as legally described in Exhibit A because of improvements being made along the foothills trail and to ensure pedestrian safety; and

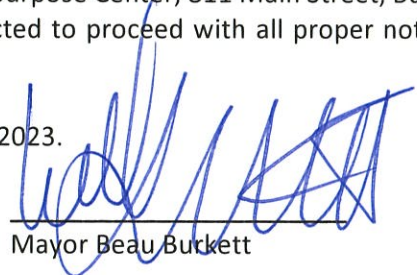
WHEREAS, the City of Buckley pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW may initiate by resolution the vacation of any street or alley or any part when it is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to initiate the vacation of Jefferson Street as legally described in Exhibit A by the resolution method as authorized by RCW 35.79.010; NOW, THEREFORE,

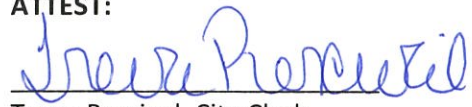
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The time and place for the public hearing and consideration of the above-referenced street vacation initiated by this resolution as authorized by RCW 35.79.010 is hereby set for 6:00pm on June 13, 2023, or as soon thereafter as can be held in the Multipurpose Center, 811 Main Street, Buckley, Washington and the City Clerk of the City of Buckley is instructed to proceed with all proper notice as required in RCW 35.79.020.
