**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF WILBUR
REPEALING RESOLUTION #269 AND SET NEW BRUSH PILE USE AND RATES
FOR ASSISTING CITIZENS IN CLEAN UP OF RESIDENTIAL AREA**

WHEREAS, the Town of Wilbur is a municipal corporation of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to repeal Resolution #269 which set seasons and times for the Wilbur residents to dispose of their yard waste free of charge at the brush site; and

WHEREAS, the Town has found the practice for having the site open for the Town residents does not fit the originally set schedule in Resolution #269; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Town of Wilbur wishes to provide this service by council motion as needed for the use by residents of the Town of Wilbur at no fee to haul branches and yard waste to the brush site;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Wilbur as follows:

1. Resolution #269 is hereby repealed.
2. The Council will provide the use of the brush pit at no fee to the Wilbur residents as set by motion on an as needed base.
3. Brush pit will remain accessible to the local citizens on the regular schedule of the Town Hall office with a fee set by the council per pick-up load.
