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# BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS LEWIS COUNTY, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 07-247

A RESOLUTION providing for the creation, powers and governance of a public facilities district to provide for the design, construction, ownership, operation, and/or financing of a public facility, including related parking facilities.

WHEREAS, Chapter 36.100 RCW (the "County PFD Act") authorizes Lewis County ("the County") to create a public facilities district coextensive with the boundaries of the County for the purposes, among others, of acquiring, constructing, owning, remodeling, maintaining, equipping, reequipping, repairing, operating and/or financing public facility(ies) together with related parking facilities; and

WHEREAS, a public facilities district is authorized under RCW 36.100.030 to acquire, construct, own, remodel, maintain, equip, reequip, repair, and operate sports facilities, entertainment facilities, convention facilities, or regional centers together with contiguous parking facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for Lewis County has determined that it is in the best interest of the County and its citizens to provide for the design, construction, ownership, operation and/or financing of a public facility(ies), for purposes including but not limited to, equestrian, rodeo, musical, and other cultural exhibitions, presentations, or performances located within the County to provide a needed public facility(ies) to serve the public and to serve local and regional businesses, community, family entertainment, youth, performance, sport, recreation and athletic organizations, to promote economic development and to further the revitalization of business, financial and commercial interests within the County; and

WHEREAS, as authorized by the County PFD Act and RCW 82.14.390, and subject to certain restrictions, a public facilities district created by a County before September 1, 2007, in which there are no other public facilities districts and in which the total population in the public facilities district is greater than 70,000, that commences construction of a new regional center before January 1, 2009, may impose solely for regional center purposes, a 0.033 percent (0.033 percent) sales and use tax that is deducted from the amount of the sales and use tax otherwise required to be collected and paid over to the Washington State Department of Revenue under Chapter 82.08 and 82.12 RCW; and

WHEREAS, this additional sales and use tax authorization is taken as a credit against the State portion of the sales and use tax and does not increase the total tax rate paid by the public, and therefore this additional sales and use tax monies would come out of monies that would otherwise go to the State. A copy of the resolution adopting the additional sales and use tax authorized by RCW 82.14.390 will be given to the Department of Revenue at least thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of the tax and the effective date of the tax must be the first of a month; and

WHEREAS, according to the Office of Financial Management's population estimates as of June 29, 2006, the population of Lewis County is 72,900, the largest city within Lewis County is Centralia, and the population of Centralia is less than forty percent of the total population of Lewis County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners following consideration of testimony at a duly noticed public hearing has determined that it is in the best interest of the County and its citizens to create a public facilities district to assist in the construction, ownership, operation, and/or financing of viable public facility(ies) or project(s) located within Lewis County;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. Creation and Purpose. Pursuant to Chapter 36.100 RCW (the "County PFD Act"), there is hereby created a public facilities district, which shall be called the Lewis County Public Facilities District (the "District", or the "Lewis County PFD") coextensive with the boundaries of the County, with the powers and authority set forth by law and below. The District is established for the purpose, among others, of pursuing the design, construction, ownership, operation and/or financing of public facility(ies) or project(s), individually or in cooperation with any other public entity as allowed by law.

As provided by RCW 36.100.010(3), the District is a municipal corporation, an independent taxing "authority" within the meaning of Article VII, section 1 of the state Constitution and a "taxing district" within the meaning of Article VII, section 2 of the state Constitution.

Section 2. Board of Directors. The Board of Directors (the "District Board") shall consist of five directors ("Directors"). The Directors of the Board shall be selected and appointed by the Board of County Commissioners to reflect the interests of cities and towns in the County, as well as the unincorporated area of the County. Of the initial Directors, two shall be appointed to two-year terms of office, and the remainder shall be appointed to four-year terms of office. Thereafter, all Directors shall be appointed to four-year terms of office.

In addition, the Treasurer of the district shall be the Lewis County Treasurer, serving ex officio as treasurer of the Public Facilities District.

If it is determined by the Board of County Commissioners that, for any reason, any, or all of the Directors should be removed from office, the Board of County

Commissioners may, if approved by two-thirds vote of the Commissioners, remove one or more Directors from office. Vacancies due to removal, resignation, or any other reason shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment and the person appointed shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term of the position to which he or she was appointed.

Section 3. Organizational Meeting. The District shall be established as of the date the enabling resolution is adopted. Within a reasonable amount of time following appointment of the initial Directors of the District Board, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners for Lewis County, or his designee, shall hold an organizational meeting of the District's initial Board, giving at least three (3) days' advance notice to each of the Directors, unless waived in writing. At such meeting, the Board shall organize itself, may appoint officers, and shall select the District's place of business.

The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, the Lewis County Treasurer and their designees are authorized and directed to take any and all additional actions as may be necessary or desirable to accomplish the organization of the District.

<u>Section 4.</u> Powers, <u>Duties</u>, and <u>Limitations</u>. For the purpose among others, of providing for the design, construction, ownership, operation and/or financing of a public facility(ies) or public project(s), the District shall have the powers, duties, and limitations specified by the County PFD Act, RCW 82.14.390 and other applicable law, that are consistent with this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Organization.</u> The District shall adopt and maintain rules of procedure and governance of its activities through bylaws duly adopted by the District Board. The power to alter, amend, or repeal the bylaws and adopt new bylaws shall be vested in the District Board, except the bylaws shall be consistent with this Resolution.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Dissolution.</u> The District shall dissolve in the event it is deemed inactive as that term is defined in RCW 36.96.010. Any dissolution of the District will be effectuated consistent with Chapter 36.96 RCW.

<u>Section 7</u>. <u>Conflicts of Interest</u>. The District shall adopt and abide by the following conflict of interest provision.

A Board member or employee of the District may not participate in Board decisions if that person or a member of that person's immediate family has a financial interest in the issue being decided unless the financial interest is a remote financial interest and participation is approved hereunder.

A Board member or employee may participate in a decision if that person or a member of that person's immediate family has only a remote financial interest, the fact and extent of the interest is disclosed to the Board in a public meeting and is noted in the minutes of the Board before any participation by the member in the decision, and thereafter in a public meeting the Board by vote authorizes or approves the participation. If the person whose participation is under consideration is a Board member, that person may not vote under this subsection. For purposes of this subsection, "remote financial interest" means:

- i) that of a non-salaried officer or director of a nonprofit corporation
- ii) that of an employee or agent of a contracting party where the compensation of the employee or agent consists entirely of fixed wages or salary and the contract is awarded by bid or other competitive process;
- iii) that of a landlord or tenant of a contracting party, except in cases where the property subject to the lease or sublease is owned or managed by the public corporation;
- iv) that of a holder of less than one (1) percent of the shares of the corporation or cooperative that is the contracting party; or
- v) that of an owner of a savings and loan or bank savings or share account or credit union deposit account if the interest represented by the account is less than two percent (2%) of the total deposits held by the institution.

A Board member or employee is not considered to be financially interested in a decision when the decision could not affect that person in a manner different from its effect on the public.

- No Board member or employee of the district shall accept, directly or indirectly, any gift, favor, loan, retainer, entertainment or other thing of monetary value from any person, firm or corporation having dealings with the District when such acceptance would conflict with the performance of a Board member of employee's official duties. A conflict, or possibility of conflict, shall be deemed to exist where a reasonable and prudent person would believe that it was given for the purpose of obtaining special
- considerations or influence; provided that application of this provision shall take into consideration the established customs and practices of the District.
  - The Board may adopt additional conflict of interest and ethical rules it considers appropriate.
- For purposes of this section, "participate in a decision" includes all discussions, deliberations, preliminary negotiations, and votes.
  - For purposes of this section, "immediate family" means:
    - i) a spouse;

- ii) any dependent parent, parent-in-law, child, son-in-law, or daughter-inlaw; and
- iii) any parent, parent-in-law, child, sibling, uncle, aunt, cousin, niece or nephew residing in the household of the corporate official or employee.

1	Section 9. <u>Limit on Liability.</u> The District shall not take action that might impose
2	liability upon the County. All liabilities incurred by the District shall be satisfied
3	exclusively from the assets, credit, and properties of the District, and no creditor or othe
4	person shall have any right of action against or recourse to the County, its assets,
5	credit, or services, on account of any debts, obligations, liabilities or acts or omissions of
6	the District.

8	Section 10. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this
9	Resolution should be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction
10	such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the constitutionality of
11	any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution.
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13	Section 11. Effective Date. This Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon
