

RESOLUTION NO. 2426

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PUYALLUP, WASHINGTON, declaring Police K9 “Marshal” as retired and surplus to the needs of the City of Puyallup and authorizing sale to Officer Matthew Hurley, for the sum of one dollar.

WHEREAS, the City owns a police German Shepherd “K9” named Marshal who after 8.5 years of service and over 525 applications, is being retired; and

WHEREAS, Marshal was purchased by the Puyallup Police Department; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it would be in the best interests of the City to sell Marshal to his previous handler rather than attempt to sell him at public auction;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PUYALLUP HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in this section in full.

Section 2. Marshal is declared retired from service and surplus to the needs of the City of Puyallup. The city manager is authorized to sell Marshal to Officer Matthew Hurley for the sum of one dollar.

ADOPTED by a unanimous vote of the City Council of the City of Puyallup, Washington on the 5th day of January 2021.


